



How to Measure Your Hatch for an Insect Screen

(Measurements should be in inches)

Tools Needed:

- Measuring tape
- A long piece of string or cordage 1/8-inch or smaller in diameter

Using the measuring tape, measure across the widest section of the hatch to determine the length and width:

1. Length: _____

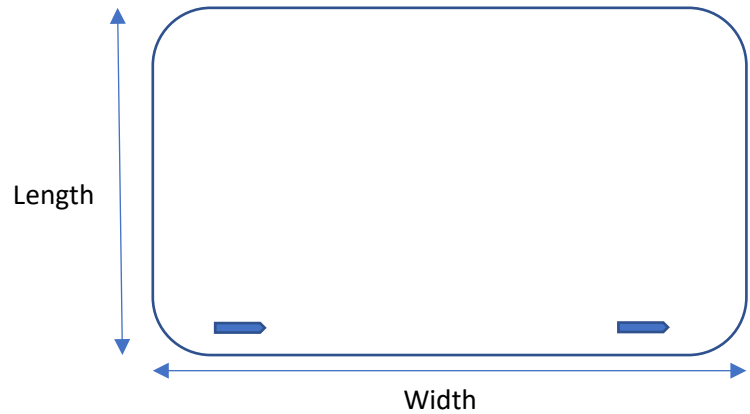
2. Width: _____

Small: Up to 15-inches

Medium: 16 – 22-inches

Large: 23 – 30-inches

X-Large: 31 – 36-inches



Using the piece of string or cordage open the hatch:

3. Measure around the concave lip on the base of the hatch – being sure to go around the backside of the vertically opened hatch (see **Red** arrow). Mark the spot where the ends meet and measure the length with the measuring tape (see **Green** arrow).
